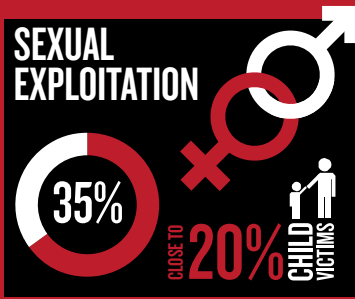


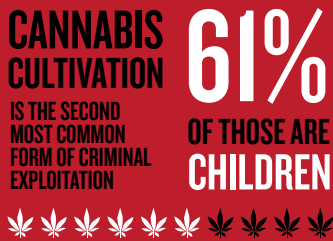
HELP FREE THE UK FROM MODERN SLAVERY
