### CARRYING A WEAPON COMES WITH CONSEQUENCES

- Knife crime has big consequences for both the victim and the offenders
- It is a criminal offence to carry a weapon, even if it is not used.
- Self-protection is not an excuse for carrying an offensive weapon. If caught carrying one, you will be arrested, prosecuted and could be convicted of a crime.
- Knife crime is not just a gang issue and can impact anyone

- Knife carriers are more likely to get stabbed as situations involving weapons can escalate quickly.
- Even if it's not you who does it, if someone is injured or killed by a knife in your presence you could be sent to prison for murder or attempted murder in what is referred to as 'joint enterprise'.
- Having a criminal record could stop you going to college or university or getting a job in the future. It could also prevent you from travelling abroad to countries such as the US and Canada.

#### STAB WOUNDS LET'S **GET TO THE POINT**

There is no 'safe place' to stab someone.

Even if you stab someone in the arm or the leg, they can still die if an artery is severed.





#### A PERSON CAN BLEED TO **DEATH IN JUST** 3 TO 4 MINUTES.

You can survive losing 20-30% of your body's blood. A loss of 40% or more, is life threatening.

#### IF SOMEONE YOU KNOW GETS STABBED

- I. CALL 999 FOR AN AMBULANCE
- 2.PUT PRESSURE ON THE **WOUND UNTIL HELP COMES**
- 3.DO NOT REMOVE THE KNIFE
