## Frequently asked questions about eLearning courses:

### What happens if I fail an eLearning course?

There is a short test at the end to ensure you have understood the subject. You will be given 3 attempts to pass the test. If you fail all 3 attempts please contact the Business Office on 01604 364036 or e-mail <u>NSCB@northamptonshire.gov.uk</u>. Your agency will be notified that you failed the test 3 times.

### What if the eLearning course won't work on my computer?

### What if I don't complete the eLearning course within 4 weeks?

You have 4 weeks to complete the eLearning Course. If you fail to complete within this timescale you will be sent a reminder. Further failure to complete within given timescales will result in a £40 charge for your organisation.

### Why does my manager need to know I'm doing an eLearning course?

You need your manager's permission to attend all NSCB courses to ensure that she/he is in agreement and that the course will contribute towards your professional development.

### Minimum computer system requirements

To access the online training, you will need internet access, an email address, and a computer with at least Windows XP or higher or OSX SnowLeopard 10.6 or higher. You will also need a compatible browser with JavaScript enabled and Flash Player 10 or above. The full list of system requirements can be found on the NSCB website.
